1. On 12 March 2009, Dr. Radovan Karadzic was notified by e-mail correspondence delivered to him at the United Nations Detention Unit that the Trial Chamber had scheduled a private conference to discuss his case with him and the prosecution in a conference room of the Tribunal on 24 March 2009. It was stated that all three judges would be present.

2. Dr. Karadzic respectfully declines to attend any private conferences in his case with the Trial Chamber or its representatives.


3. He respectfully requests that any and all proceedings in his case be held in public in a courtroom of the Tribunal.

4. Dr. Karadzic has also been served with several e-mails over the past week reflecting communication between the Trial Chamber and the prosecution. He requests that the Trial Chamber communicate with the parties by public filings and not private communications, so there is a full record of all such communications in the file of his case. He requests that all such communications to date be filed as public documents in his case file and any such communications in the future be made available to the public in the same manner as public orders or decisions.

4. No disrespect to the Trial Chamber is meant by this request. However, Dr. Karadzic insists on full transparency in his case.
